

Thank you for visiting Feedback Sports LLC's websites ("Site") and Privacy Policy. Feedback Sports LLC is referenced as Feedback Sports, We, Us, or Our. All the paragraphs in Our Terms of Use and Disclaimer are included in this Privacy Policy as if specifically written here. By visiting Our Site, you agree to the practices described in this Privacy Policy.

This Privacy Policy may be updated as Our organization changes. Updates or changes will be posted here.

Foreign Privacy Practices. By visiting Our Site, you consent to the applicability of U.S. practices, rules, regulations, and laws, exclusively, and agree that no other country or jurisdiction's practices, rules, regulations, or laws will apply to Our privacy practices.

Acquisition of Information. We do not acquire any more information about individuals purchasing products or accessing Our Services than is required by law or is otherwise necessary to provide Our Products and Services unless you provide it to Us voluntarily. We do not provide your personal information to unrelated third parties without your consent.

Personal information, as used in this Privacy Policy, means your name, email address, street address, phone numbers, birth date, social security number, credit card information, geo-location information, and persistent identifiers that can be used to recognize a user over time and across different sites or online services.

In some instances, you may voluntarily submit personal information to Us. For example, you may provide personal and credit card information. If you opt not to provide Us with personal information, you may be unable to have a purchase request fulfilled.

Any information you provide will be transferred to and processed by a computer server that may be located in the U.S.A. or elsewhere in the world. By Our Terms, We intend that all such information will be subject to U.S. laws. We cannot, however, make any commitment regarding how foreign governments may deal with information stored in a server outside the U.S. We comply with industry standard methods to maintain the confidentiality of such information.

Sharing Your Information. We will use personally identifiable information you provide to Us to send you information on Products and Services if you request it or to process financial transactions. We also collect information from individuals who contact Us through the "Contact Us" portion of Our website to respond back to you. We will use your personal information to provide you with additional information, materials, and news about Our Products and Services that We believe may be of interest to you or to troubleshoot technical problems if you contact Us. You may opt out of such communications by contacting Us at info@FeedbackSports.com or by selecting the "unsubscribe" link available in each email We send.

We may use third parties, such as vendors, contractors, or partners, to assist Us. These third parties who have access to your personal information in connection with providing Products or Services are required to keep the information confidential and are not permitted to use this information for any purpose other than to carry out the services they are performing or to market Our Products and Services to you as long as you have the option to opt out of that communication.

We may share personal information if all or a part of Our company is sold, merged, dissolved, acquired, or is transferred in a similar transaction.

Otherwise, We do not share personally identifiable information with third parties unless (a) you, or your legal guardian, authorize such sharing, (b) We are compelled to share personal information by an order of a duly-empowered governmental authority (including, but not limited to, a court order) or to comply with laws or regulations. In the circumstances detailed in section (b) in this paragraph, your information may be divulged without your consent.

Email Inquiry. If you send an email inquiry to Us, the return email address is used for the answer. We do not use the return email address for any other purpose and do not share it with any third party.

Non-personal Information. Personal information does not include Internet protocol (IP) addresses, Cookies (defined below), device identifiers, URLs for web pages, dates and times you visited Our Site, time spent on Our Site, the number and location of mouse clicks, the address of previous websites you visited if you linked to Us from another website and other technical information. Additionally, non-personal information may include de-identified aggregate data. Such information is considered non-personal information. Our Services and Site may collect and store this non-personal information as well as technical, non-personally identifiable information about your device. We use this information to improve Our Products and Services, performance of Our Site, information security and for other internal and commercial purposes. Such information may also be utilized for insurers, researchers or others to review Our Products and Services.

Deletion of Personal Information. If you would like to review or delete any personal information you have provided to Us, please contact Us at info@Feedbacksports.com. We will request that you verify your identity prior to sharing information with you. Please know that if you ask Us to delete information, We will maintain a backup of that information for a period of 3 years or as otherwise required by law.

Access To, and Control Over, the Use of Your Information. In the event you sign up for a user account, you will be able to access, correct, and update your personal information. You will be asked for your ID and password so that We are able to process your changes. We will use reasonable efforts to correct any factual inaccuracies in your information. Failure to update such information, however, will not be considered a breach of this Privacy Policy.

We will not share any more consumer information than is necessary with Our business partners; and We will make every reasonable effort to assure, by contract or otherwise, that they use information provided to them in a manner that is consistent with this Privacy Policy.

Cookies. We may use "Cookies." Cookies are pieces of information that a website transfers to your computer hard drive to remember that your browser software visited a website. Cookies can identify a particular computer, but not an individual user. Third party entities that We use to provide functionality may also use their own Cookies. We do not control use of Cookies by third parties and expressly disclaim responsibility for information collected through them.

Browser Cookies are small data files created by a website and stored on your computer. Cookies enable Us to recognize your browser on return visits and to remember your preferences. You may block Cookies through your browser's preferences and controls, but doing so may disable some of the features of Our Site.

Security of Your Information. It is important that you protect your logon ID and password to keep your User Content confidential and to protect your account, if any. However, discounts may not be available if We are unable to track how you located Our Products and Services.

Public Areas of Internet. Please remember that any information you may disclose in any public areas of Our Site or the Internet becomes public information. You should exercise caution when deciding to disclose personal information in these public areas.

Linked Site. Our Site may provide links to other websites. We have no control over a third party's use of any personal information you provide. We urge you to exercise care when providing personal information to anyone. We are not responsible for the privacy policies, content, or data handling practices of other websites.

Advertising. Should We ever use third party advertising companies to serve ads when you visit Our Site, such third party companies may use information (not including your name, address, or email address) about your visits to this and other websites to provide advertisements on Our Site and other websites about goods and services that may be of interest to you. - To provide the parents with notice and to seek consent for communications with the child. Note: this may require collection of the parent's email address as well.

- To respond more than once to a child's request; i.e., subscription to a newsletter, however, parental consent is required prior to the second communication.
- To protect the safety of a child who is using Our Products and Services; e.g., in a chat room.
- To protect Our Products and Services, including Our Site, or to respond to law enforcement; i.e., in the case of a website compromise.

Personal information about children under 13 years of age may be needed to respond to their communication to Us, such as to receive a publication. We will use commercially reasonable efforts to destroy personal information about your child immediately upon completion of its intended purpose once We know the request is not from an adult, or if We are informed that no parental or legal guardian permission has been signed.

Otherwise, We do not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from children, either directly or passively, except when a child voluntarily submits such information through (i) a "Contact Us" link on a child's area of Our Services or (ii) a public posting area, if such features are available. We will never request personally identifiable information from a child in any of Our public postings areas. Please note that any online store that may be accessed from Our Site is intended for parents and other adult purchasers over the age of 18 and requires the submission of personally identifiable information to fulfill any transactions.
